
This document will help you to complete the necessary steps to offer Amazon Payments to your customers. In order to integrate this payment method on your site, you will need to use your **Merchant ID** and **MWS access keys** to configure RomanCart. Below is described the process of registering an account and how to obtain the requested information.

1. Registering an Amazon Payments account



2. Verifying the account

Once registered, verifying your account is a mandatory step to accept payments.

2.1. Log into Seller Central

- › Open <https://sellercentral-europe.amazon.com/gp/homepage.html>
- › Login using your email and password created in step 1
- › Ensure that you are in the payments.amazon.co.uk area by using the dropdown box in the top left of the page.

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Merchant:

- › Navigate to 'Settings' > 'Account Information' or use the alert link from the home page.

2.2. Enter your Passport

You will be required to enter passport information at this stage. Scroll down to 'Account Status Amazon Payments Europe' and select the Edit button.

- › Passport details will be required for all company owners

2.3. Enter your bank account

For the transfer of funds, Amazon requires banking details to be entered into the account. From within the Account information page, scroll down to 'Deposit Method' and select the Add button. From the Global Bank Account Information page, please add.

- › Bank Account Information
- › Bank Sortcode
- › Bank Account No
- › Bank Account holders Name

Your account will then be submitted for review.


2.4. Additional information

During the review process it may be necessary to provide proof of address or recent utility bill.


3. Finding your Merchant ID

Please note, this step can be done right after registration, while the account is being verified.


3.1. Select the Production environment (non sandbox)

3.3. Here is your Merchant ID




3.4. Please insert your Merchant ID in the RomanCart configuration GUI


4. Creating your MWS access keys

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MWS Access Key

When you use Advanced Integration, you send a request to process an order either through HTML or XML. When you send your request, you need an Access Key.

Checkout by Amazon uses Access Keys from Amazon MWS (Amazon Marketplace Web Services). To generate a signature, you need an Access Key. For more information on Access Keys, including when to use them and how you calculate them, please refer to the [Integration Guide](#).


